The minimum requirements for the above courses are as below: Entry requirements:

- At least a C grade in Biology, Chemistry and Physics & a D grade in Mathematics and English for those candidates who sat UCE in 2024 under the new lower secondary education curriculum. Or Aat least a pass 8 in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics and English for the other candidates that sat UCE under the old lower secondary education curriculum.
- II. Both Original and Photocopies of Pass Slips
- III. Attach Passport size Photograph on the application form.
- IV. The applicants are required to pick an application form from the nearest centre, fill it with the required information, attach relevant photocopies of pass slips and certificates and return to the very centre from Monday 10th April to Friday 3rd May, 2025.
- V. Only applicants with minimum requirements as stated above and are 18 years and above will be provided access to interview centres
